

Press release Pension fund ABP will build nature inclusive wind park in the North Sea with Noordzeker

Amsterdam, June 11 2024

Noordzeker, an initiative of pension fund ABP, in cooperation with asset manager APG, and developer SSE Renewables, has been selected to build a new wind farm in the North Sea with a capacity of about 2 GW, enough to green 8% of current Dutch electricity demand. The wind farm will be built 62 kilometers off the Dutch coast near IJmuiden. The award for the new wind farm concerns the IJmuiden Ver Alpha tender. This tender focuses on the ecology of the park to be built. Noordzeker aims to provide large-scale renewable energy at an attractive price, with a minimal ecological footprint and a positive impact on biodiversity.

To achieve these objectives, Noordzeker will work closely with Naturalis Biodiversity Center both during the construction and operational phases of the wind farm. Together with Naturalis, research and monitoring will be conducted at the wind farm to determine how wind farms can best help combat climate change and contribute to biodiversity in the North Sea. Noordzeker will also introduce a range of other measures, such as artificial reefs, shutting down wind turbines during periods of high bird activity, and removing marine litter. In this latter program, autonomous vessels will collect litter to clean the habitat of seabirds and other marine life.

"With Noordzeker, we have the ambition to operate a large wind farm in the North Sea. Together with Naturalis, we want to raise the ecological bar for the development, construction, and management of wind parks in the North Sea", says Harmen van Wijnen, Chair of ABP. "This will ensure a good financial return for our pension participants and affordable, clean energy for the Netherlands, for the benefit of people and planet. We look forward to taking the next steps."

More details on innovations and research programmes will be announced at a later stage.
